- 2. Prepare for the CUSP exam by utilizing the optional CUSP Prep and live webinar sessions.
- 3. Register to take the CUSP base exam and one endorsement exam that you specialize in.

The CUSP certification program and CUSP Prep are available online which eliminates travel costs, logistics, and time away from work. The costs shown below represent USOLN membership pricing..

- o \$155 <u>USOLN annual membership</u> fee (optional, costs go up for <u>non-members</u>)
- o \$799 CUSP Prep (optional)
- o \$275 CUSP base exam and one endorsement exam
- o \$1,229 Total

After passing my CUSP exam, I'll receive a digital CUSP card, certificate, my name on the <u>CUSP roster</u> and the <u>company name</u> on the <u>USOLN website</u>.
